Your Duty of Disclosure

Before you enter into a contract of insurance with an insurer, you have a duty to disclose to the insurer every matter that you know, or could reasonably be expected to know, is material to the insurer's decision whether to accept the risk of the insurance and, if so, on what terms. You have the same duty to disclose those matters to the insurer before you renew, extend, vary or reinstate a contract of general insurance. You are to give us notice in writing as soon as possible of every change materially varying any of the facts or circumstances existing at the commencement of this insurance. Your duty, however, does not require disclosure of a matter:

- that diminishes the risk to be understood by the insurer
- that is common knowledge
- that your insurer know or, in the ordinary course of his/her business, ought to know
- as to which compliance with your duty is waived by the insurer

Who needs to tell us

You must answer our questions in this way for you and for anyone else whom you want to be covered by the policy.

Non-disclosure

If you fail to comply with your duty of disclosure, the insurer may be entitled to reduce their liability under the contract in respects of a claim or may cancel the contract.

If your non-disclosure is fraudulent, the insurer may also have the option of avoiding the contract from its beginning.
